Also, we would like to review with you a few important items regarding guidelines for Advanced Placement Examinations.

Students **<u>should</u>** bring the following items to the exam(s):

- Two sharpened pencils with erasers
- Two ballpoint pens (black or dark blue)
- Two approved calculators visit apstudents.org/courses to find the calculator for your subject
- A ruler or straight-edge if you are taking the AP Physics Exam
- A watch that does not have internet access, beep or make noise, or have alarm access

Students **<u>should not</u>** bring the following items to the exam(s):

- Electronic equipment includes cell phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, recording or listening devices, or any electronic communication device. A student observed with any of these devices during testing or breaks may be dismissed from the exam and his/her test will be invalidated.
- Books, reference guides, notes, compasses, protractors, dictionaries, highlighters, or colored pencils
  - Watches that beep or have alarms
- Food and/or drink
- Backpacks <u>will not</u> be allowed in the testing room or the hallways outside of the testing room. Please leave them at home or store them in students' lockers.

Finally, if you are absent either all or part of an exam day, a written excuse from your parent/guardian must be provided. Students are expected to attend classes before and after exams.
