

A note about obtaining books:

There are many ways to obtain books for independent and/or summer reading besides purchasing the books.

Each of the required summer reading books for the AP/College level classes is available for free through the Westchester Library's digital collection. This collection also provides audiobooks. Students can access the digital collection through <https://westchester.overdrive.com>, or <https://hoopladigital.com>. Once logged in, a student can join waitlists and check out books at 7 or 14-day increments to be read on Kindles, computers, phones, or other internet-enabled devices. Hoopla resources do not have a cap on the number of people who can access them at once, therefore Hoopla resources are more available than Overdrive resources. Pelham Memorial High School students also have access to part of the Westchester Public Library's digital collection, without a library card, through the SORA app. SORA can be customized to access the New York Public Library digital collection. Students can use SORA through their Pelham Launchpad. Audiobooks are also available through SORA.
